WORKSHOP OUTLINE

1. Introduction and Demonstration Water Check

An introduction to basic landscape irrigation principles and observation of landscape water checking techniques.

2. Weather

How sunlight, humidity, wind and temperature influence water loss through plants and from the soil surface.

3. Plants

Basic principles of plant management that will maintain plant health and beauty while minimizing water use.

4. Soils

Understanding the relationships among soils, irrigation water and plants.

5. Irrigation

Understanding maintenance practices that will keep a system operating at peak efficiency and uniformity as well as irrigation scheduling practices.

6. Field Exercises

Practicing landscape Water Check techniques and calculations.



The workshop goal is to aid landscape professionals, property managers and maintenance staff for large institutions, public agencies, government agencies, commercial businesses and HOAs in troubleshooting inefficiencies, maintenance and scheduling of irrigation systems. Each workshop will cover topics vital to scheduling and maintaining efficient landscape irrigation systems. Workshops will be held from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. (See schedule below); cost is \$10 per person.
